Course Title: Introduction to Psychology | Schedule: 9:00am-10:25am

Course Description: This course will provide students with a comprehensive introduction to the world of psychology. Through a combination of engaging lectures, interactive discussions, and hands-on activities, students will explore the fundamental principles and key topics in psychology, gaining insights into the workings of the human mind and behavior. This course is designed to inspire a lifelong interest in understanding human behavior, fostering critical thinking skills, and providing a foundation for further studies in psychology and related fields.
