Course Title: Science Literacy | Schedule: 10:35am-12pm

Course Description: This course will prepare students for general science-based regents exams. Science regents will now test students' ability to incorporate claim evidence reasoning, reading comprehension, and analysis of diagrams and models to aid in explaining their answers. Students will improve their understanding of science concepts, the scientific process, and how science relates to society. Topics will cover understanding scientific evidence, evaluating claims, and applying scientific knowledge to real-world situations-all important skills in preparation to be college ready for science level courses.

Additional Information: This course is designed for high school students interested in improving their science comprehension for test preparation and college readiness for science courses.

Salary: \$1,125 = [\$45 an hour x 2.5 hours (1.5 hours of instruction + 1 hour of preparation) x 10 sessions]

Prepare and teach curriculum for 20-22 students

- Evaluate student and group performance
- Provide staff with measurable results in student learning through assessments
