Housed in LaGuardia's Division of Adult & Continuing Education, CIET provides no-cost educational and training programs designed to assist low-income immigrant English language learners to advance on their educational and career pathway. The primary responsibilities of this position include:

- The ability to develop & implement vocational lesson plans based on nursing material for ELLs
- Co-teaching, co-planning and working with academic team; teaching independently.
- Development of quizzes, management of ATI software to monitor student progress.
- Attend weekly team meetings; communicate instructional needs and progress.
- Keep attendance and complete administrative paperwork on time.
- Supports the design and delivery of the NCLEX preparation program to ensure high quality academic development and delivery of language teaching and learning.
- Assists with program development, needs and instructional assessment, and outcome evaluation as well as student recruitment, enrollment and detention.
- Prepares analytical and statistical reports for management.
- Track student progress, attendance and satisfaction, as required by funders and the university.
- Assist with the design of lesson and curriculum; identify appropriate instructional materials to share with faculty.
- Collect, review, and provide feedback on lesson plans for faculty according to funder and department requirements; serve as a resource to part-time faculty on ESOL curricular and instructional matters.
