General Description

The Program Coordinator position will be a full-time role for the first two years, transitioning to part-time for the next three years. The Program Coordinator will work closely with Principal Investigators (Pls) to manage and coordinate the R25 NIH grant with the Science and Technology Entry Program (STEP) and partnering schools. This role requires work on Saturdays, after-school hours, and some evenings.

- · Coordinate with Pls, and STEP on recruitment efforts for the program.
- Monitor budgets and assist with the preparation of reports and regulatory documents.
- Facilitate recruitment, outreach, and networking activities.
- Collect data and provide advisement and communication support.
- Organize enrichment opportunities and track program budgets.
- Oversee student recruitment and retention efforts.
- Collaborate with college departments to ensure program success.
