GENERAL DESCRIPTION:

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Must have Bachelor's degree in Computer Sciences or related field, Master's Degree preferred;
- Experience with business applications related to higher education, facilities planning, construction and management;
- Must have a minimum of 3 years of experience in system analysis, design and development of web applications using Cold Fusion and MS VB.net;
- Must know HTML v.5, and CSS, and be able to imbed, trouble-shoot and test both JavaScript and VB Scripts within web pages;
- Must have created and maintained databases on MS SQL;
- Must have administrated an MS SQL server and demonstrated creating/testing/trouble shooting backup

schedules and performing restores, including writing and debugging SSIS scripts;

- Must have at least 3 years hands-on experience in utilizing MS IIS web services;
